Immerse yourself in “Making a Splash! – New Swimmer Paintings by Jamie Wayman”. Wayman, a nationally noted painter of swimmers refreshes us with a sparkling new series of works.

Jamie Wayman made a stunning debut with HORNE Fine Art in 2003 in the group show, *Splash!*, organized around a water theme. Identified by Salt Lake Magazine and Southwest Art as an important emerging artist, Jamie Wayman continues to delight her audience with this new series featuring pool scenes. The works range in sizes for every collection, from miniature to large. They have Wayman’s trademark playfulness and array of reflections. Boys dive for water rings. Sisters chat on the pool’s edge. Babies wiggle as they test the water.

Ripples on the water’s surface distort and transform our perspective – shattering figures into a kaleidoscope of colors and shapes. Wayman brings a jewel-like sense of detail and a brightening palette to these canvases, while still evoking the uniqueness of the world as seen from underwater.

The works also have an strong emotional undercurrent – celebrating the joys of childhood and family life around the pool. Since receiving recognition for her earlier series of swimmer paintings, Jamie has dived into parenthood – and is now raising a boy and girl toddler. With both she and her husband as master swimmers, initiation of the children into the pool was early, providing ample and fresh subject matter for paintings.
